None	A public charity with a 50% deductibility limitation.

1. Allowable Deductions:
  - a. Public Donations
  - b. Memorial Donations
  - c. Goods - some examples could be:
    - i. Plants
    - ii. Raffle Items
    - iii. Town Common Wish List items
  - d. Services
    - i. Professional work done – as an example, if you are a landscaper, you can submit a bill for your time and labor if doing work for the DGC. DGC will issue you a check. You may then write a check to DGC for the same amount as a donation.
  - e. Out of Pocket Expenses
    - i. Mileage to/from Post Office (as an example)

(Note: Members need to keep track of their expenses for this type of deduction)

For 2009, the Treasurer will be sending letters to all persons who donated to the Daffodil Public Planting (or any other monetary donation) by January 31, 2010. If any Club member would like a letter from the DGC for any other donation, please let me know and I'll send you one after you give me a monetary value.

Going forward, as donations are made, an acknowledgement will be sent via email (if available) or regular mail at the time of the donation.
